5 201 KAR 16:533. Examination requirements for allied animal health professionals.

6 RELATES TO: KRS 321.175, 321.181(1)-(4), 321.235

7 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 321.175(2)(c), (5), 321.181(1)-(4), 321.235(1)(a)-
8 (c), (2)(b)2.

9 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 321.235(1)(b) and (2)(b)
10 authorize the board to promulgate administrative regulations in accordance with KRS Chapter
11 13A to effectively carry out and enforce the provisions of the Kentucky Veterinary Medicine
12 Practice Act. KRS 321.235(2)(b)2. requires the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners to
13 establish examination requirements and passing scores for allied animal health professionals.
14 This administrative regulation establishes examination requirements as one part of the
15 requirements to qualify for an allied animal health professional (AAHP) permit from the board.

16 Section 1. State Exam Qualifications for Allied Animal Health Professionals.

17 (1) The board shall require a passing score on the Kentucky Board of Veterinary
18 Examiners Jurisprudence Examination for AAHPs ~~a board-approved state jurisprudence~~
19 ~~examination~~ as one requirement for permitting by the board as an allied animal health
20 professional.

21 (2) Candidates seeking an AAHP permit shall pay a state examination fee pursuant to 201
22 KAR 16:513.

1 (3) Candidates shall successfully complete the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners
2 Jurisprudence Examination for ~~AAHPs Allied Animal Health Professionals~~, which shall cover
3 the specific requirements of KRS Chapter 321 and 201 KAR Chapter 16, in either paper or
4 electronic format.

5 (4) To successfully complete the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners Jurisprudence
6 Examination, Applicants for an AAHP permit shall be required to achieve a score of eighty (80)
7 percent or higher ~~on the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners Jurisprudence Examination~~
8 ~~for Allied Animal Health Professionals~~.

9 Section 2. National Exam Qualifications for Allied Animal Health Professionals.

10 (1) The examination required for permitting by the board as an allied animal health
11 professional shall be the successful completion of a certification exam required by an approved
12 allied animal health professional program, pursuant to 201 KAR 16:523. An official score report
13 or official documentation from the certifying body shall be provided from the certifying body to
14 the board.

15 (a) American Veterinary Chiropractic Association
16 (ACVA) passing score shall be seventy percent (70%) or
17 the passing score set by ACVA, whichever is higher.

18 (b) International Veterinary Chiropractic Association (ICVA) passing score shall be
19 seventy percent (70%) or the passing score set by ACVA, whichever is higher

20 (3) Applicants for an AAHP permit to the board shall pay any required national exam or
21 score transfer fees directly to the approved allied animal health professional program, ~~or one of~~
22 their designee designees, or official records custodian.
