5 RELATES TO: KRS 321...

6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 321...

7 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 321.... requires the Kentucky Board of
8 Veterinary Examiners to establish required examinations and passing scores for allied
9 professionals. KRS 321.235(3) and 321.240(5) authorize the board to promulgate administrative
10 regulations to implement KRS Chapter 321. This administrative regulation establishes
11 examination requirements to qualify, in part, for allied professional permitting by the board.

12 Section 1. State Exam Qualifications for Allied Professionals.

13 (1) The board shall require a passing score on a board-approved state jurisprudence examination
14 as one requirement for permitting by the board as an allied professional.

15 (2) Candidates seeking an allied professional permit shall pay an examination fee pursuant to 201
16 KAR 16:513.

17 (3) Candidates shall complete the Commonwealth of Kentucky State Board Examination, which
18 shall cover the specific requirements of KRS Chapter 321 and 201 KAR Chapter 16, in either
19 paper or electronic format.

20 (4) Applicants for an allied professional permit shall be required to achieve a score of eighty (80)
21 percent or higher on the Commonwealth of Kentucky State Board Examination.

1 Section 2. National Exam Qualifications for Allied Professionals.

2 (1) The examination required for permitting by the board as an allied professional shall be the
3 successful completion of a certification exam required by an approved allied professional
4 program, pursuant to 201 KAR 16:523.

5 (3) Applicants for an allied professional permit to the board shall pay any required fees directly
6 to the approved allied professional program or one of their designees.
