8 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 321.235(1)(b), 321.236(1)(b)

9 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 321.235(1)(b) requires the Kentucky

10 Board of Veterinary Examiners to promulgate administrative regulations to effectively carry out

and enforce the provisions of KRS Chapter 321. KRS 321.236 requires all veterinary facilities to

register with the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners. KRS 321.236(5) requires each

13 registered veterinary facility to identify both a veterinarian manager and each registered

14 responsible party who shall be responsible for the operation and management of the veterinary

15 facility. This administrative regulation establishes the responsibilities for registered responsible

16 parties and veterinarian managers.

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Section 1. Definitions.

18 (1) "Fixed facility" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS 321.181(38).

(2) "Mobile facility" or "mobile unit" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS
321.181(46).

1	(3) "Practice of veterinary medicine" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS
2	321.181(50).
3	(4) "Practice of veterinary technology" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS
4	321.181(51).
5	(5) "Registered responsible party" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS
6	321.181(57).
7	(6) "Veterinarian manager" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS 321.181(68)
8	(7) "Veterinary facility" is defined by has the same meaning as KRS 321.181(71).
9	Section 2. <u>Duties of Registered Responsible Parties</u> . A registered responsible party shall
10	(1) Be responsible for maintaining minimum standards as promulgated by the board in
11	administrative regulation;
12	(2) Designate a veterinarian manager veterinary manager for the registered veterinary
13	facility;
14	(3) Comply with Ensure the requirements of and ensure employees and volunteers at the
15	veterinary facility comply with the provisions of KRS Chapter 321 and 201 KAR Chapter 16 are
16	met in addition to all local, state, and federal laws governing operations at the veterinary facility;
17	and
18	(4) Comply with all duties to report, in accordance with Section 4 of this administrative
19	regulation, including the timely designation of a veterinarian manager for the facility.; and
20	(5) Ensure compliance with minimum veterinary facility standards set forth in 201 KAR
21	16:701, 16:702, 16:705, 16:710, 16:715, 16:720, 16:750, and 16:805, as applicable to the
22	registered veterinary facility.
23	Section 3. <u>Duties of Veterinarian Managers</u> .

- (1) A veterinarian manager shall: 1 2 (a) Be responsible for maintaining minimum standards as promulgated by the board in 3 administrative regulation; (b) Maintain a Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners veterinarian license; 4 (c) Comply with all provisions of the Kentucky Veterinary Medicine Practice Act and 5 6 201 KAR Chapter 16, in addition to all local, state, and federal laws governing operations at the veterinary facility; 7 (2) The veterinarian manager shall be: 8 9 (a) The individual who oversees veterinary services at a veterinary facility; (b) Knowledgeable about the veterinary facility and its: 10 (i) Daily operations, 11 (ii) Standard protocols, 12 (iii) Drugs and supplies, 13 (iv) Patient areas, 14 (v) Storage structures 15 (vi) Other organizational spaces, and 16
- 17 (vii) Parts and spaces, both indoors and outdoors, of the veterinary facility;
- 18 (c) Present at the veterinary facility with enough frequency to have knowledge of and
- 19 control over the facility's methods for complying with minimum standards and the degree to
- 20 which the minimum standards are being met; and
- 21 (d) Available and responsive to the board, its staff, inspectors, or other board designees,
- in the event of a facility inspection or any inquiry or investigation by the board.

1	Section 4. Duty to Report. Either the registered responsible parties or and veterinarian
2	managers shall report to the board:
3	(1) Within thirty (30) days, any Any change of <u>name</u> , address, phone, or email to the
4	registered facility within thirty (30) days by completing and submitting to the board the Request
5	for <u>Facility Information</u> Name or Address Change form or online equivalent form provided by
6	the board, including all required attachments;
7	(2) Within ten (10) days, a A change in the veterinarian manager for the registered
8	veterinary facility within ten (10) days on the Request for a New Veterinarian Manager form or
9	online equivalent form, including all required attachments, as incorporated by reference in 201
10	KAR 16:543;
11	(3) Any infraction of KRS Chapter 321 or 201 KAR Chapter 16 by themselves or another
12	person at the veterinary facility within fifteen (15) days; and
13	(4) A written response to a grievance or inquiry from the board <u>in accordance with 201</u>
14	KAR 16:610 within twenty (20) days of receipt.
15	Section 5. Compliance and Disciplinary Action. Registered responsible parties and
16	veterinarian managers shall comply with the KRS Chapter 321, 201 KAR Chapter 16, and other
17	applicable federal, state, and local laws, or shall be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to
18	KRS 321.235(2)(h) or 321.351.
