4 201 KAR 16:583. Board issued allied professional permits, inactive status.

5 RELATES TO: KRS 321....

6 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: KRS 321....

7 NECESSITY, FUNCTION, AND CONFORMITY: KRS 321.235(3) and 321.240(5) authorize
8 the Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners to promulgate administrative regulations to
9 implement KRS Chapter 321. KRS 321.235 authorizes the board to promulgate administrative
10 regulations regarding the issuance and renewal of retired and inactive permits. This
11 administrative regulation establishes the procedures for the issuance and renewal of retired and
12 inactive allied professional permits.

13 Section 1. Inactive License Status for Allied Professional Permits.

14 (1) An allied professional permittee of the board with a permit in active status may request an
15 inactive permit status by:

16 (a) Submitting a completed application Request for Licensure Status Change form or online
17 equivalent form, including all required attachments; or

18 (b) Designating their intent to convert to inactive status on the appropriate renewal form during a
19 renewal period in accordance with 201 KAR 16:573.

20 (2) A permittee whose license is designated with an inactive status shall pay a renewal fee during
21 each license cycle in accordance with 201 KAR 16:513.

1 (3) Proof of current status with an approved allied professional program shall not be required for
2 permittees while in inactive status.

3 (4) A permittee whose permit is in an inactive status may request reinstatement to an active
4 license status by:

5 (a)

6 1. Completing and submitting the Reinstatement Application for Allied Professionals or online
7 equivalent form, including all required attachments; or

8 2. Designating intent to reinstate to active status on the appropriate renewal form during a
9 renewal period in accordance with 201 KAR 16:573;

10 (b) Completing and providing proof that the allied professional degree or certification is in
11 'active' or 'current' status with the certifying entity identified in 201 KAR 16:523; and

12 (c) Paying the reinstatement fee pursuant to 201 KAR 16:513.

13 (5) There shall be limit of ten (10) years that an allied professional permit may remain in an
14 inactive status.

15 (6) An allied professional whose permit is in an inactive status shall not practice their profession
16 in any capacity within the Commonwealth of Kentucky as long as the permit remains in inactive
17 status.

18 Section 2. Inactive License Status by board action.

19 (1) An allied professional with a board permit in active status shall be moved to inactive
20 licensure status by the board if:

21 (a) Their professional license to work on humans lapses, expires, is suspended, revoked,
22 terminated, ... ; or

1 (b) Their certification from an approved allied professional program lapses, expires, is
2 disciplined, ...

3 (3) An allied professional whose permit is designated with a status of inactive shall renew the
4 permit during the next renewal cycle, or the permit shall expire.

5 (4) An allied professional whose permit is in an inactive status pursuant to subsection (1) of this
6 section may request reinstatement to an active certificate status by:

7 (a)

8 1. Designating their intent to reinstate to active status on the Renewal Application for Allied
9 Professionals form as found in 201 KAR 16:573 during a renewal period; or

10 2. If within five (5) years of expiration, submitting a completed Reinstatement Application for
11 Allied Professionals form, including all required attachments and fees; and

12 (b) Paying the reinstatement fee pursuant to 201 KAR 16:513; and

13 (c) Being approved for reinstatement by the board.

14 (5) An allied professional whose permit is in an inactive status shall not practice their profession
15 in any capacity within the Commonwealth of Kentucky as long as the permit remains in inactive
16 status.

17 Section 3. Background checks. The board may conduct a national or jurisdictional level
18 background check on each applicant for reinstatement. The check shall be processed by a board
19 approved background check provider, and may include a copy of the applicant's fingerprints
20 captured at a board approved location. The board may reject background checks that do not have
21 an official seal or watermark, or that are more than ninety (90) days old. The board may impose
22 additional requirements as a condition of permitting or deny permitting following the board's
23 review of findings from a background check.
