2020 Approved CEs List

As detailed in 201 KAR 16:590, Section 2, approved CE courses for Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians include:

- (a) All scientific programs of all organizations of the American Veterinary Medical Association [AVMA], its constituent organizations, and its recognized specialty groups and accredited veterinary medical institutions whose meetings impart educational material directly relating to veterinary medicine;*
 - (b) Programs approved by the Registry of Approved Continuing Education (RACE) of the American Association of Veterinary State Boards (AAVSB);*
 - (c) Accreditation modules offered by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS); and*
 - (d) All programs approved by the board pursuant to subsection (2) of this section.*
- (2)(a) By a majority vote, the board may approve programs that are deemed to impart knowledge directly relating to the practice of veterinary medicine, including the utilization and application of new techniques, scientific and clinical advances, and the achievement of research to assure expansive and comprehensive care to the public.*
- (b) To request approval, a completed Request for Continuing Education Approval form shall be submitted to the board.*

The list in this document constitutes a complete accounting of all currently approved CE by the KBVE for the current year since the last Board Meeting, but does not include the list approved by AVMA or AAVSB. 201 KAR 16:590, Section 1(1), requires that a **Veterinarian** shall complete thirty (30) hours of CE during the biennial renewal period, from Oct 1 of an even year through September 30 of the following even year. *At least twenty (20) hours shall be directly related to the practice of Veterinary Medicine; and no more than ten (10) hours shall be in areas not related to veterinary medicine such as practice/business management.*

201 KAR 16:590, Section 1(2), a requires that a **Veterinary Technician** shall complete six (6) hours of CE.

For licensees who are **newly graduated and/or newly licensed**, there are exceptions to CE requirements. The Board also offers an **Inactive Status option** where no CE is required. Please visit the Board's website at www.kybve.com/continuing-education.html to learn more.

There is **NO LIMIT** to the number of online hours used for the CE as long as the requirements of 201 KAR 16:590 are met. View the full regulation at <https://apps.legislature.ky.gov/law/kar/201/016/590.pdf>.
